

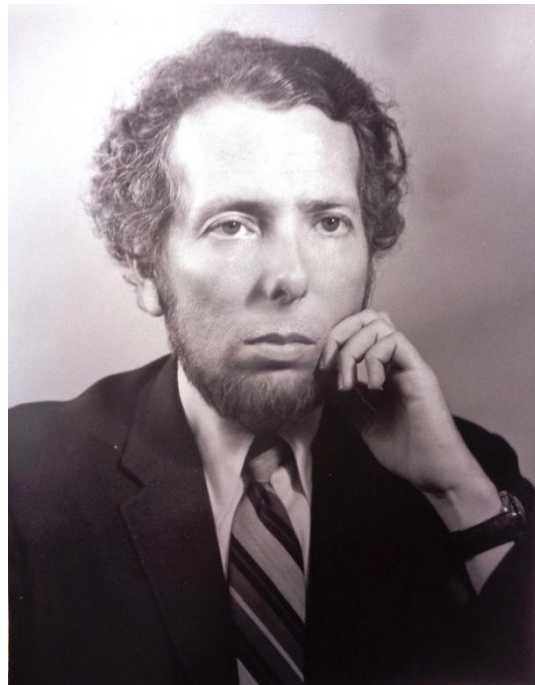
## Call for chapter proposals, July 2025
